

Cover: A possible pathogenesis of cisplatin-induced rat renal fibrosis. After tubular injury (necrosis and apoptosis), the interstitial fibrosis with abnormal regeneration of tubules is progressed via a possible functional shift of infiltrated M1/M2 macrophages which may be induced via cytokines (IFN-γ, TNF-α and IL-6 produced mainly by M1 macrophages and TGF-β1 produced mainly by M2 macrophages), TLR-2/-4 and biglycan (a component of the extracellular matrix) as the damage-associated molecular patterns.
