Aims and overview of the Asian Union of Toxicologic Pathology

Name: The Asian Union of Toxicologic Pathology (AUTP)

Aim: Promotion of the development and cooperation of research and practical works of toxicologic pathology in the Asian area

Organization: Member societies are national/regional toxicologic pathology societies (TPSs) in the Asian area. The founding member societies include Japanese Society of Toxicologic Pathology (JSTP), Korean Society of Toxicologic Pathology (KSTP), Society of Toxicologic Pathology-India (STP-I) and Chinese Pharmaceutical Association - Society of Toxicologic Pathology (CPA-STP)

Secretariat: For the time being, the secretariat of JSTP takes care of the AUTP secretariat business.

Policy:

- 1. AUTP is a loose union for the mutual aid of TPSs in the Asian area.
- AUTP discusses and acts on the collaborative extraction and resolution of problems, and the
 collaborative proposal and realization of the modernization and innovation, about the broadranged themes with regard of toxicologic pathology.
- 3. AUTP discusses and acts on the education and lifetime training of toxicologic pathologists of various levels, from the entry to expert.
- 4. AUTP discusses and acts on the appeal of the board certification of TPSs to regulatory bodies.
- 5. AUTP tries to recruit either individuals or TPSs in nations/regions outside of those of the founder member societies.
- 6. AUTP holds its meeting in a bi- or triannual basis, as a joint meeting with one of the member TPSs.
